Supervisor Bono opened the meeting at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

AGENDA: Greg Reuter made the motion the agenda is accepted, Jim Lundrigan 2nd it, all in favor, so moved.

MINUTES: Minutes from the July 13th regular meeting were read by Town Clerk, Tracy McLain. Patty Bikowsky made a motion the minutes are accepted as read, Greg Reuter 2nd it, all in favor so moved.

Supervisor Bono states that the movers have begun to move everything out of the Madison County Courthouse, cost of \$160,000 for moving that the state will pay for. The 2 year construction plan to make it handicap accessible and an addition will be paid for by the county. The tabled commercial housing definition in the site plan and to change the local law was voted down with a motion made by Greg Reuter, 2nd by Patty Bikowsky, all in favor so moved.

The Board has been given correspondence letters from 5 Lake Moraine residents. Nancy Reis spoke and feels there are ecological concerns over the 4 year weed harvesting that has been done by Enviro Aquatics, a weed harvesting company owned by Damian Croyle, also a Lake Moraine resident. Ann Palmiter speaks on behalf of the Lake Moraine Association as a board member and states they have been working on the research of plant growth. Mike Cragolin states he has had to deal with more weeds on his property and shoreline within the last 4 years. All residents that spoke have asked the town board to act upon this issue. Supervisor Bono states that as a township, we do not have regulatory authority on the body of water as it is owned by the state. The board will have the town clerk send a letter stating the residents' concerns to both the DEC and county planning board.

Supervisor Bono presented the following resolutions to the board for their consideration:

17-10 to move monies in the amount of \$10,000 from the DA savings and \$100,000 from the DB savings and into the general fund checking to cover August bills. Jim Lundrigan made the motion to adopt the resolution, Patty Bikowsky 2nd it, roll call vote 4 votes yes.

Bills in the General Account in the amount of \$ 20,955.19 and bills in the Highway Account in the amount of \$ 135,944.47 for a total of \$ 156,899.66 were audited and approved for payment with a motion made by Patty Bikowsky, 2nd by Jim Lundrigan, all in favor, so moved.

At 8:05PM Patty Bikowsky made the motion to adjourn, Jim Lundrigan 2nd it, all in favor, so moved.
