17-20 to accept Bryn on the Books audit for Judge Engle. Jim Lundrigan made the motion to adopt the resolution, Brad Dixon 2nd it, roll call vote, 5 votes yes.

17-21 to accept Bryn on the Books audit for Judge Hynes. Greg Reuter made the motion to adopt the resolution, Patty Bikowsky 2nd it, roll call vote, 5 votes yes.

17-22 to move money from the DA savings in the amount of \$5,000 and into the general fund checking account to cover June bills. Jim Lundrigan made the motion to adopt the resolution, Brad Dixon 2nd it, roll call vote, 5 votes yes.

Bills in the General Account in the amount of \$ 28,573.41 and bills in the Highway Account in the amount of \$ 59,966.93 for a total of \$ 88,540.34 were audited and approved for payment with a motion made by Patty Bikowsky, 2nd by Brad Dixon, all in favor, so moved.

At 8:35PM Patty Bikowsky made the motion to adjourn, Brad Dixon 2nd it, all in favor, so moved.
