Supervisor Bono opened the public hearing on the 2% tax cap override with a motion made by Jim Lundrigan, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Greg Reuter, all in favor so moved. With no public comment, Greg Reuter made the motion to close the public hearing, Patty Bikowsky 2<sup>nd</sup> it, all in favor so moved.

Sherry Thompsen from Frank Road asked the board about placing a storage shed on a non-conforming lot. Jim Lundrigan made the motion to approve this building placement, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Brad Dixon, all in favor so moved. Jim Lundrigan then made the motion to work on amending the Local Law on land use regulations, Patty Bikowsky 2<sup>nd</sup> it, all in favor so moved.

Supervisor Bono states that the state has a family leave mandate that has been made voluntary for municipalities to enroll. The board has agreed not to offer this to town employees. Highway Superintendent Kirley states that there has been no correspondence on the FEMA monies at this time.

Supervisor Bono presented the following resolutions to the board for their consideration:

17-29 to approve the budget modifications to balance the budget. Jim Lundrigan made the motion to adopt the resolution, Patty Bikowsky 2<sup>nd</sup> it, roll call vote, 5 votes yes.

17-30 to adopt Local Law #1 to override the tax cap. Patty Bikowsky made the motion to adopt the resolution, Brad Dixon 2<sup>nd</sup> it, roll call vote, 5 votes yes.

17-31 to move monies in the amount of \$325 from the Aquatic Growth Money Market and into the general fund checking to cover October bills. Greg Reuter made the motion to adopt the resolution, Jim Lundrigan 2<sup>nd</sup> it, roll call vote, 5 votes yes.

Bills in the General Account in the amount of \$ 28,309.11 and bills in the Highway Account in the amount of \$ 110,744.96 for a total of \$ 139,054.07 were audited and approved for payment with a motion made by Patty Bikowsky, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jim Lundrigan, all in favor, so moved.

At 8:05 PM Patty Bikowsky made the motion to adjourn, Brad Dixon 2<sup>nd</sup> it, all in favor, so moved.
